The Royal Thai Embassy presents its compliments to the Royal Thai Honorary Consulate in Vilnius and has the honour to inform the latter that, by the Ministerial Regulation of the Ministry of Interior of the Kingdom of Thailand dated 10 January 2019, Thailand will implement a temporary Visa on Arrival (VoA) fee exemption scheme, starting from 14 January 2019 to 30 April 2019.

The scheme applies to nationals and holders of passports/travel documents of the countries/territory who are entitled to apply for VoA at the designated immigration checkpoints. It is applicable only for tourism purposes and stay for up to 15 days.

During the aforementioned period, nationals and holders of passports/travel documents of **Andorra, Bulgaria, Bhutan, China (excluding Hong Kong and Macao), Cyprus, Ethiopia, Fiji, India, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Maldives, Malta, Mauritius, Papua New Guinea, Romania, San Marino, Saudi Arabia, Ukraine and Uzbekistan and Taiwan** are exempted from Visa on Arrival (VoA) fee of 2,000 Baht.

The Royal Thai Embassy kindly requests the Royal Thai Honorary Consulate in Vilnius to publicize the information regarding the temporary Visa on Arrival (VoA) fee exemption scheme for nationals of the said countries on its website as well as at the Honorary Consulate.

The Royal Thai Embassy avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Royal Thai Honorary Consulate in Vilnius the assurances of its high consideration.
